### **The Future of the Marine Parade Shelters**

#### **PUBLIC EXHIBITION**

**Friday 7 December to Monday 10 December**

**Woodmead Halls - small hall**

Heighway Field Associates of Exeter, on behalf of Lyme Regis Town Council, have prepared a range of preliminary possibilities for designs and uses. These possibilities build on the public consultation held in late 2006, as reported to the Town Council and the public in April 2007.

They will be on public display at the Woodmead Halls from Friday 7 December to Monday 10 December.

What you will see are NOT finished proposals. They illustrate ideas intended to help the town and its Council to find the most appropriate way forward to a more complete solution.

You are invited:

- to look at the ideas shown, and to consider what would best suit the needs of Lyme Regis, its residents and its visitors.
- to offer written comments and suggestions which you think will be valuable to Heighway Field Associates and to the Council.

#### **PUBLIC MEETING**

**Monday 10 December**

**Marine Theatre. 7.30pm**

The exhibition moves to the Marine Theatre late on the afternoon of Monday 10 December for an open public meeting in the Theatre, starting at 7.30pm on that day.

Members of the Heighway Field team will explain the general background to their approach, talk about the exhibited possibilities, and report on the results of their consultation within the town, and on their preliminary cost/structural assessments. The meeting will then be open for discussion and questions.

Please join us to share your ideas if you possibly can.

Following that meeting, Heighway Field Associates will review all the comments and suggestions, and will advise the Shelters Regeneration group and the Council on ways forward. There will then be a special meeting of the Town Council on 19 December to agree on the preferred route, so that in the New Year work can begin on the next stages of development.
