# 5. Roof Replacement above the Swim, the antiques and craft centre and the amusement arcade

To allow members to consider a condition survey report on the roof above the Swim, the antiques and craft centre and the amusement arcade

To approve resurfacing proposals and schematic designs for the roof above the Swim, the antiques and craft centre and the amusement arcade

To increase the council budget for this project from £200,000 to the budget estimate of £332,000 which was submitted as part of the LEADER grant application

To receive initial comments from the tenants of these establishments on the proposals and design

To consider the observations and considerations made by John Stark and Crickmay Partnership and the town clerk and to determine the most appropriate course of action
