3. If any election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday, 26th May 2022.
4. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on Tuesday, 10 May 2022.

5. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at County Hall, Colliton Park, Dorchester, Dorset, DT1 1XJ by 5 pm on Wednesday, 11th May 2022.
6. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at County Hall, Colliton Park, Dorchester, Dorset, DT1 1XJ by 5 pm on Wednesday, 18th May 2022.
7. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at County Hall, Colliton Park, Dorchester, Dorset, DT1 1XJ by 5 pm on Thursday, 26th May 2022. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Wednesday, 18th May 2022. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5 pm on Wednesday, 18th May 2022.
